Meeting with a funding source or Accessiblity Advocate?

This is a checklist of paperwork that may help you advocate your rights to accessible spaces.

	An accessibility evaluation report or doctor/therapist prescription
	Age of person needing funding
<u> </u>	Written description of how it has or will benefit you
<u> </u>	Written record of any accessibility related services received in the past

	Copies of other documents related to the disability (prescriptions, receipts, etc)
