

## Advocacy Checklist: What to bring

Meeting with a funding source or Accessibility Advocate?

This is a checklist of paperwork that may help you advocate your rights to accessible spaces.

- An accessibility evaluation report or doctor/therapist prescription
- Age of person needing funding
- Written description of how it has or will benefit you
- Written record of any accessibility related services received in the past
- Receipts for any accessibility services or equipment expenses, if available
- Copies of other documents related to the disability (prescriptions, receipts, etc)
- Types of public assistance you currently receive
- Background info/guidelines for the funding source(s) you are pursuing
- Any questions you may have regarding your accessibility needs
- Any questions you have have regarding the process to obtain funding
